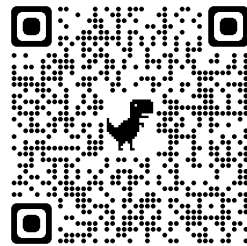

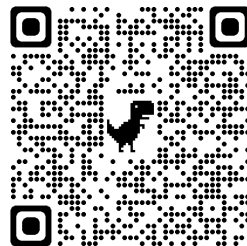
Aloha Board Members and Neighbors,
